Clean-up, Plant-up Day

April 14th 9-noon

Here is what I'm proposing for the Saturday, Aril 14 clean-up and planting day prior to the Pancake Breakfast.

Saturday, April 14, 9 a.m. to noon.

Five teams headed by a Lion.

- 1. Omaha Beach -- hasta team I -- divide and spread existing hasta, treat with root-starter
- 2. Utah Beach -- hasta team 2 -- plant 10-12 new hastes arrayed across the front and side of the building.
- 3. Sword Beach -- Shasta daisies (3,000 seeds) -- soil prep and sowing along west fenceline
- 4. Utah Beach -- Wildflower mix (30,000 seeds) -- soil prep and sowing along west borderline A
- 5. Gold Beach -- Hummingbird/butterfly perennial seeds (1 lb.) -- soil prep and sowing along borderline B

This will require the landscape service to roto-till the flower/hasta beds prior to April 14 (and, if they're mulching, do so after the 14th -- no mulch on the flower seeds, pls.)

We'll need two or three Lions and an equal number of Scouts (or more, if possible) on each Beach.

And, we'll need all the volunteers to come armed with spades, hoes and trowels.

I'd like to have Operation Overlord ready to present at Tuesday's meeting, if you concur.
